IS HE NOT YOUR FATHER, YOUR CREATOR?

Deuteronomy 32.1-18; John 1.1-13

*Is this the way you repay the LORD,
O foolish and unwise people?
Is he not your Father, your Creator,
who made you and formed you?"* Deuteronomy 32.1-9

Throughout the Bible, and in particular the book of Deuteronomy, God uses the land as a tool to teach. Deuteronomy is actually a book with significant emphasis upon agriculture. Deuteronomy is also the most quoted of all the books of the Bible, and therefore, the Bible is a book about agriculture.

In the Song of Moses in Deuteronomy 32, Moses is giving words of instruction and warning to the second generation of Israelites as they are about to enter "the land flowing with milk and honey" (31.20). What does Moses' poem to Israel teach them/us? (Deuteronomy 31.19-22, 30)

IN THE DESERT LAND HE FOUND THEM, 32.10-13

*"In a desert land he found him, in a barren and howling waste.
He shielded him and cared for him; he guarded him as the apple of his eye."* 32.10

"Then, as the LORD our God commanded us, we set out from Horeb and went toward the hill country of the Amorites through all that vast and dreadful desert that you have seen, and so we reached Kadesh Barnea." Deuteronomy 1.19

*"Rebuke your mother, rebuke her, for she is not my wife, and I am not her husband.
Let her remove the adulterous look from her face and the unfaithfulness from between her breasts.
Otherwise I will strip her naked and make her as bare as on the day she was born;
I will make her like a desert, turn her into a parched land, and slay her with thirst."*
Hosea 2.2-3
