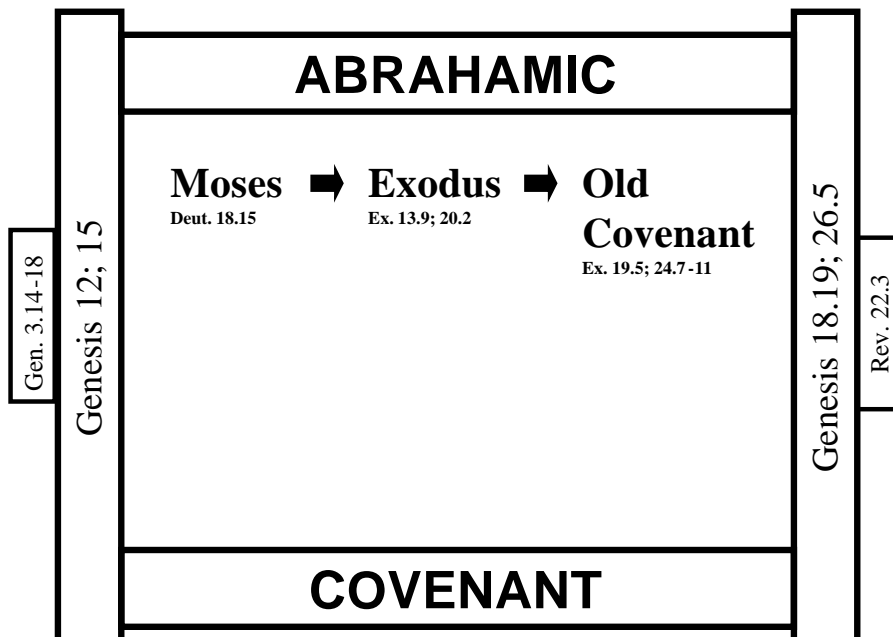
And so when we consider Moses we are going to be given insight into the definition of the problem. What problem is being corrected? The problem of **Conflict** is addressed.
