The New Covenant was designed by God to remedy the long-standing problem of sin in Israel and the world.

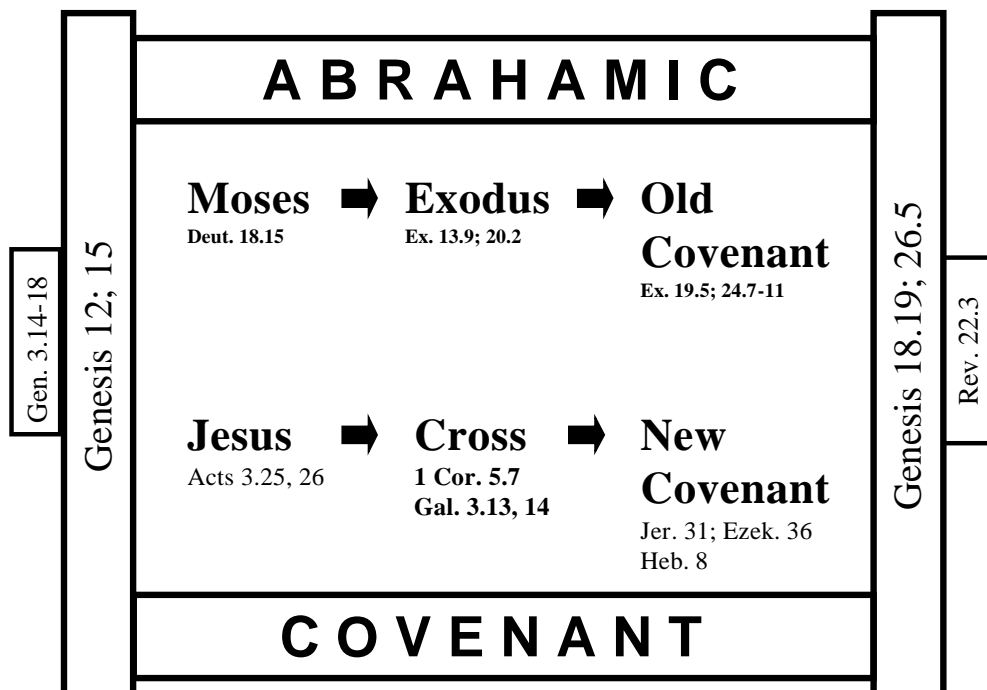
So, once again God has defined the problem. The question then becomes, "How will He get around to solving it?" Who was the greater prophet about which Deuteronomy 18:15 talks?

We Need A Great Leader (Acts 3.19-26)

Moses was a leader, and Joshua was a leader, but Acts 3 tells us that Deuteronomy 18.15 was talking about "The Leader," Jesus, who is in fact "The Greater Prophet."

We Need A Great Act of Redemption

1. The Breaking of Bondage (1 Corinthians 5.7-9).
2. The Giving of Direction (Hebrews 8.1-13).
